MAJOR PROJECTS IN WORK AT DET 14

TTL and Syllabi rewrite: Changes to the B-1 RTM have driven TTL and Syllabus changes for all training phases. All currently under revision.

B-1 Simulator Upgrades: B-1 simulators undergoing a massive upgrade of visual displays and hardware started Sep '10. Only one of two integrated simulators (1 front station / 1 aft station) will be available at a time. Initial upgrade completion is delayed but should be completed in Jul '11. All this creates a potential scheduling backlog for FTU syllabus training.

IBS Training Development: First IBS modified aircraft expected in Fall '12. Approximately 80% of courseware requires revision/rewrite. Seeking additional CWD funding.

Upgrade/Replacement of B-1 Cockpit Procedure Trainers: Future issue. Aircraft hardware upgrades (IBS/SB-16) are incompatible with current training devices. Need to secure funding to update trainers or identify how to get basic switch/task training through another medium (CFMs?).
